ORDER

The institutions mentioned in the table under para 3 below had submitted applications to the Western Regional Committee of National Council for Teacher Education for grant of recognition to B.Ed. and M.Ed. in terms of Section 14(1) and 15(1) of NCTE Act, 1993, among others.

2. The WRC at its 89th meeting held from September 27th, 2006 at Bhopal considered applications of the institutions included in the Agenda for the meeting and after careful examination of relevant documents, Visiting Team Reports, Video Recording etc. and the institutions compliance reports on deficiencies found the institutions mentioned in para 3 below fit for grant of recognition of the courses and intake mentioned against their names.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to these institutions from the session 2006-2007 for the course and intake as under.

4. The institutions shall ensure the fulfillment of the following :-

- The institutions shall maintain the teaching staff strength of 1+7 for the sanctioned B.Ed. and 1+3 for the sanctioned M.Ed. course and all the appointments would be on regular basis on an approved scale of payment of the candidates having fulfilled eligibility condition prescribed by NCTE. The institute concerned shall send a report in this regard to WRC of NCTE within 30 days, in terms of clause 7 (12) of the NCTE Regulations 2005.
- The institutions shall note that with regard to NET / SLET requirement, the relaxation is allowed only upto the year 2009-2010 as per NCTE Regulation dt. 21.7.2006.
- The institutions shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.
